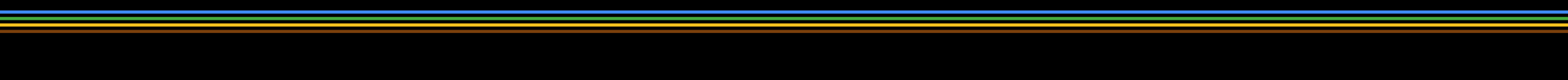

Rethink we did.

- We met a few years ago to create a resilient fiber network design
- Split the country up in smaller regions
- Each region had multiple connections to other regions
- Each region has five regional interconnects that are connected with a full mesh network



On top of the fiber:
An IPv6 based network
