Internet Exchange operators DE-CIX and Netnod sign Memorandum of Understanding for future partnership

Frankfurt am Main (Germany), Stockholm (Sweden) – 14 May 2020. The world's leading Internet Exchange (IX) operator DE-CIX and the largest IX provider in the Nordics, Netnod, have signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) agreeing on a partnership going forward. In a first step, this partnership includes the direct interconnection of the world's largest IX by peak traffic, DE-CIX Frankfurt, and the Stockholm-based Netnod IX via GlobePEER Remote and Netnod's Remote IX service. In addition, both companies have agreed to sell each other's interconnection services. The reseller activities also relate to all active locations of the respective parties. This partnership is planned to be extended to other Netnod IXs in the Nordics in due course, expanding DE-CIX's global interconnection ecosystem to the highly digitally-mature Northern European region and vice versa.

"With Netnod, we have found the ideal partner to further extend DE-CIX's global reach to Northern Europe and the Nordics. Netnod and DE-CIX share the same DNA and experience, as we have both been in the business for decades. Through this partnership, we are creating optimal synergies for both companies – interconnecting Stockholm and Frankfurt with the GlobePEER Remote service.
